Dear Customer,

You are receiving this letter in addition to the construction letter to provide you further information on what to expect in the coming months. The Philadelphia Water Department has hired Pio Construction Inc. to make repairs to the water and sewer mains, as well as the sidewalks and roadway. ADA ramps will also be replaced at the completion of the underground work.

Once the Water Department contractor is finished, our partner utilities will need to do their work, which could potentially take a couple of months as well. We anticipate that all work will be completed in this intersection with the roadway back open to traffic in approximately 6 months. We will provide you updates throughout the process, so you know what to expect as work progresses.

There will be minor parking restrictions while this work gets underway, and the parking spaces closest to the intersection will no longer be available as the heavy equipment will need room to maneuver and be stationed. We understand this can be an inconvenience, and will move quickly to minimize the disruption.

As always, please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions or concerns, and I will do my best to address them. Please note, during construction, concerns should be directed to the project inspector, whose information can be found in the letter from the Construction Engineer.

We look forward to continuing to work with you all during the next phase of this work, and appreciate your continued patience and understanding while we work to restore this intersection.
